



# Measurements for Butter Bunny

Clay Colors you need to  
**have on hand:**

Yellow	
darker Yellow	
Coral	
White	



## Notes for using the size chart

Adjust to the size you need, this is just to guide you if you want exactly copy what I did. Some size charts are slightly different, so you might need to size up or down a little, but the main thing is to keep symmetry throughout. For example both feet use the same mold.

When there is a bold “**2x**” it means you need to measure two times the same mold to get the right amount and “**1/2**” indicates that you only need half of the measured amount. “Tiny” means it’s just a speck and “handful” is more than the largest mold can fit.

When there is multiple of the same parts, it will be indicated with “(2)”, “(3)” etc. and the measurement is for each part individual.

Head	Yellow	<b>2x</b> 40mm
Body	Yellow	33mm
Ear (2)	Yellow	No. 5
Foot (2)	Yellow	22mm
Tail	Yellow	22mm
inner ear (2)	dark yellow	9mm
toe (6)	dark yellow	2.5mm
paw pad (2)	dark Yellow	5mm
Arms (2)	Yellow	9mm
Butter Spread (head)	Yellow	5mm
Whipped cream	White	37mm
