








# Measurements for Gingerbread Girl

Clay Colors you need to  
**have on hand:**

Brown	
White	
purple	
red	
black	

**3 inch**



**1.5 inch**

# Notes

Mix your black clay with a little bit of white to make it a little more firm. If any other of your clay is too soft or sticky add a little white as well.

If you see this ~ in front of the measurement you wont need all the clay, just use what you need.

When there is a bold “**2x**” it means you need to measure two times (or how ever many it states) to get the right amount and “**1/2**” indicates that you only need half of the measured amount. “Tiny” means it’s just a speck and “handful” is more than the largest mold can fit.

When there is multiple of the same parts, it will be indicated with “(2)” and the measurement is for each part individual.



## Amounts of Clay you need to make each part:

Part	Color	<a href="#">size chart</a>
Body	Brown	40mm
Head	Brown	40mm + 33mm
Feet (2)	Brown	19mm
Arms (2)	Brown	15mm
Bow (middle)	red	12mm
Bow (2 loops)	red	15mm
Button (2)	purple	9mm

for the frosting details just roll out a small amount of white and cur off any over hang

for the eyebrows and mouth roll out a small amount of black as thin as possible and cut to the size you need
