



Measurements for Halloween Octopus

Clay Colors you need to
have on hand:

light purple	
purple	
yellow	
black	
green	
orange	
pink	
white	



Notes

Mix your black clay with a little bit of white to make it a little more firm. If any other of your clay is too soft or sticky add a little white as well. (The Clay in the DIY Kit is pre mixed, but in weather might call for this step)

If you see this ~ in front of the measurement you wont need all the clay, just use what you need.

When there is a bold "**2x**" it means you need to measure two times (or how ever many it states) to get the right amount and "**1/2**" indicates that you only need half of the measured amount. "Tiny" means it's just a speck and "handful" is more than the largest mold can fit.

When there is multiple of the same parts, it will be indicated with "(2)" and the measurement is for each part individual.

Part	Color	size chart
Cauldron	Black	Handfull
Cauldron legs (4)	Black	12 mm
Potion	Green	29mm
Potion bubbles (~20)	Green	~29mm
Cauldron handle (2)	Black	9mm
Octopus arm (large)	Purple	29mm
Octopus underside (large)	light Purple	25mm
Pink sucker (4)	Pink	1/4 15mm
Orange sucker (6)	Orange	1/8 15mm
Yellow Suckers (8)	Yellow	1/2 9mm
small yellow suckers	Yellow	1/4 9mm
Head	Purple	2x 29mm
small Arm	Purple	25mm
small underside	light Purple	15mm



WATCH NOW

Amounts of Clay you
need to make each part:

Part	Color	size chart
Suckers for small arm (6)	Yellow	1/4 - 1/2 9mm
Skin Spots	light purple	random small pieces
Cheeks	Pink	1/2 9mm
Eyeball (2)	White	19mm
Iris (2)	orange	9mm

You don't have to be accurate with the suckers and spots but just for those of you who really need specific sizes I gave you exactly what I did.
